From Palermo Airport (Falcone-Borsellino Airport)

Palermo Airport is located approximately 35 km from the city center. Below are an array of different transportation options to reach the Marina Convention Center.

Bus

Airport Shuttle Bus: Operated by Prestia e Comandè Route: From the airport to Palermo city center Stops: Stop near the Marina Convention Center (Piazza Ruggero Settimo Stop; consult the bus driver for details) Frequency: Every 30 minutes Duration: Approximately 50 minutes Cost: ≈ €6 one-way Tickets: Available online, at the airport, or directly from the driver

Train

Route: Trenitalia runs regional trains connecting the airport to Palermo Centrale station. From Palermo Centrale: The Marina Convention Center is a short taxi or public transport ride away Frequency: Every 30 minutes Duration: Approximately 45 minutes Cost: ≈ €5.90 for a one-way ticket Tickets: Purchase at the train station or online via Trenitalia's website

Car Rental

Car rental services are available at the airport. Major providers include Hertz, Europcar, and Avis. Driving time to the Marina Convention Center is approximately 40 minutes. GPS or navigation apps are recommended for directions.

From the Marina Convention Center, it is easy to access Palermo city center with public transport or by walking. Palermo's bustling markets, such as Ballarò and Vucciria, are a must-see, offering authentic Sicilian cuisine and local crafts. Don't miss a visit to Palermo's Cathedral and Teatro Massimo, Italy's largest opera house, both located right in the city center.

The average temperature in January in Palermo is approximately +10/+15°C during the day, making it mild and comfortable compared to other European cities.
